Valentine's Day Fudge

Ingredients:

- 2 cups white cake mix
- 2 cups powdered sugar (or as we call it here – icing sugar)
- 1/2 cup butter, cut into four pieces
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1/4 cup Wilton Valentine's sprinkles

Directions:

1. Add cake mix and powdered sugar to a microwaveable bowl. Mix together.
2. Add in butter and milk. Do not mix. Microwave for 2 minutes on high.
3. Remove from microwave immediately and stir together to combine. Stir in Valentine's sprinkles.
4. Immediately spread the batter in an 8×8 greased baking pan. Add a few sprinkles to the top and press down with the palm of your hand or a spoon to set in place.
5. Refrigerate for 2 hours or until set. Cut into squares and enjoy!

"The day the music died" is a line in the 1972 Don McLean hit "American Pie." McLean's song, which he wrote in the late 1960's and released in 1971, was in part inspired by the tragic event which took the lives of three great musicians and their pilot.
